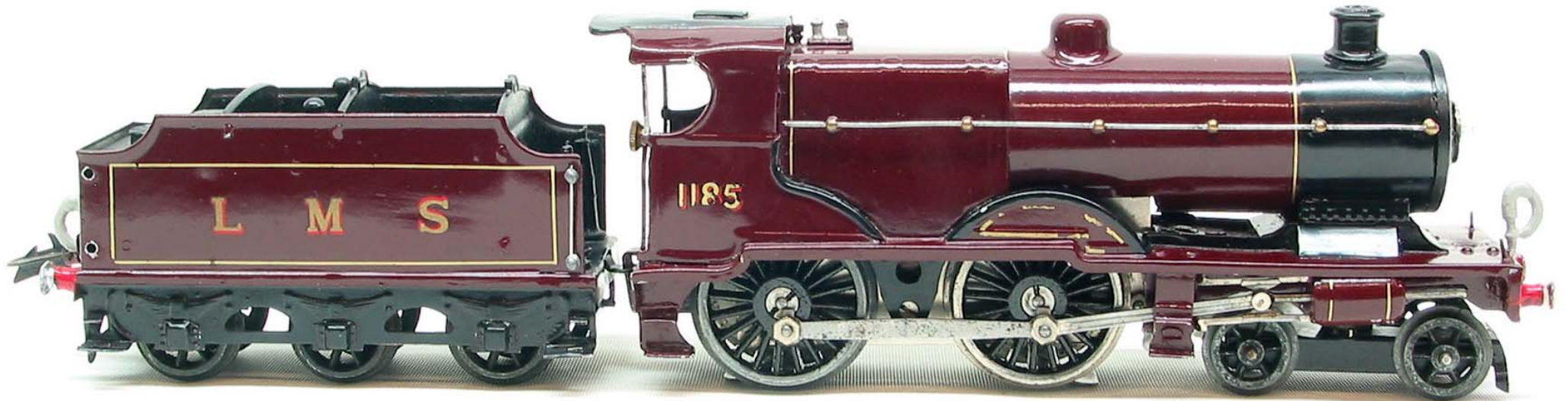

## O Gauge Hornby No2 Special 4-4-0 Compound Tender Locomotive repainted in Black "Export" Livery to customers requirements

### Background:

The client provided as a "donor" model an O Gauge Hornby Electric LMS Compound 4-4-0 Tender Locomotive no 1185 to have various plate work issues attended to and to be liveried in the style of a Special Order Black, lined Gold version of this loco that was produced by Hornby for Export between 1937 and 1939.

### Work completed:

#### Plate Work repaired:

- Improve ripples in Cab Roof and RH Side of Cab. Improve depression at the front of Smoke Box, below chimney, along to where it meets the SB Front pressing. Repair split to beading on RH Cab cut out. Realign twist in RH Rear Running Plate below Cab.
- Replace Rusty Boiler Hand Rail Wire. Tender - LH Brake Stanchion Operating Handle missing (replace with that provided). Tender - RH Rear Hand Rail & Knob Missing (replace with those provided)

#### Livery painting:

- Paint in Special Order Black, lined Gold Export Livery, hand lining in the style & finish of Hornby (Gold Lining as Special Order Black No 2 Special on page 136 of The Hornby Gauge O System by Chris & Julie Graebe, with the addition of the lined Cylinders)
- Application of appropriate reproduction Hornby detailing transfers "1185" "LMS" and Hornby Trademark Transfers.
